

Innex Wheel Club of Bangalore Compiled by Ann Meera Bai Shankar



he Anns of Rotary club of Bangalore had been working as "Rotary Anns Club" and were rendering a lot of social service. In fact, a considerable amount was collected by them towards the building fund of Rotary House of Friendship also.

It was when they attended the Rotary Dist. Conference at Belgaum in 1966 along with their Rotarians that the seed of the Inner Wheel' was planted in the minds of the Rotary Anns of Bangalore club. The seed took roots and began to grow as the Inner Wheel Club of Bangalore the same year with Mrs.Sowrya Chandrashkara Swamy as President, Mrs.Kamala Padmanabhan as Secretary with 20 Anns as charter members. Then the next year under the leadership of Mrs. Malathi R. Rao, other clubs were encouraged to be formed and the result was the forming of Inner Wheel Dist.317(South) with Malathi

as the Charter Chairman. Then, when the Rotary bifurcated we became Inner Wheel Dist.318 and again in 1977 with another bifurcation we became Dist.319 and continued to be so.

In our Club we have 9 PDCs, One IIWR - Mrs. Malathi R. Rao and One Association Past President - Mrs. Prema Ullal.

1952-53

Their first service in helping Rotarians was in the Kadugodi Village Centre. The Rorary Anns assumed responsibility for the upkeep of the primary School and teaching the villagers about hygiene, child care and gardening. They collected cloths and medicines for distributions among the villagers during their weekly visits to the Centre. Also presented books to poor Children of the School. These were in addition to supervising the overall work of the Centre.

1954-55

Organised a Bridal Pageant, the proceeds of which went to the fund for the 100-bed Rotary TB Ward at the Shantabai Devarao Shivaram Sanatorium in Bangalore.

1955-56

Arranged a Temple Fair and collected Rs.7,000. Of this, Rs.5000 was given for the construction of the Rotary Block at the Ramakrishna Boys Home in Basavanagudi, Bangalore.

1956-57

Organized a harmonica recital by a well-known artiste from USA. The proceeds were shared with S.S.V Charities.

1959-60

Organized a Handloom Fashion Show Parade. The collections were donated towards the construction of the Seva Ashrama Dispensary at Sriramapuram.

1960-61

Organized a Pot-pourri Night of Indian folk dances and songs. The proceeds were given to the Rotary Charitable Trust.

1963-64

Arranged an International Night, From the collection, Rs.6,000 was given to the Rotary House of Friendship Building Fund.

1964-65

The Rotary Anns Club of Bangalore came to be known as the Inner Wheel Club of Bangalore.
