MAURICE DUPERREY, Paris, France
President, Rotary International, 1937-38

Maurice Duperrey is the proprietor of chemical products and abrasives manufacturing companies in Paris, France, and he is president and administrator of several Paris hotels. He was born in Paris.

Mr. Duperrey became a member of the Rotary Club of Paris in 1926 and is a past president of that club. He has been active in Rotary International as president (in 1937-38), vice-president, director, district governor, and as committee chairman and member.

He is a Counsel for Foreign Commerce in France, and honorary president of the Permanent Committee of Foreign Fairs in the French Ministry of Commerce. He is honorary president of the National (French) Abrasive Syndicate, honorary president of the National (French) Federation of Polishing Materials Manufacturers, vice-president of the French Association for the Study of Foreign Languages, and honorary general secretary of the National Committee of Counsels for Foreign Commerce in France.

In addition to his native language, he is versed in English, Spanish, German and Italian. He has traveled extensively in Europe, North and South America and in North Africa, and he has made 70 crossings of the Atlantic Ocean. During his year as president of Rotary International, he received decorations from the governments of Brazil, Bulgaria, Chile, Ecuador, Lebanon, Peru, Syria, Italy and Czechoslovakia.

In recognition of his services in World War I, he received the French Croix de Guerre and the British Military Medal. He is a knight commander of the French Legion of Honor, awarded by the government "to a man who has devoted all his life to service on the national and international level in accordance with the precepts of the Rotary ideal".
